Protocol For Reporting Advanced Rostered Players

**To Aid League Officers in Spotting Eligible Players Playing in Too Low of a Division

- 1) Team Captain registers formal Report, including reported Player's Name, Jersey Number, Team and a brief List of Objections for that player staying in their current Division (i.e. Skating Speed, Shot, Stick Skills, etc.)
- 2) Once 2 or more Captains have identified a specific individual, League Officers will monitor 2 or more games to make a ruling.
- 3) Games 4-13 are open to Report 'Advanced' players
- 4) If a player is determined by League Officers to be too 'Advanced' for their current division, and the League mandates that player be moved up, that team's Captain will be issued a 1-game suspension for rostering a player that creates an unfair competitive advantage
