They made it clear that this will be happening to all large ice rinks in Montgomery County.

We have seen this similar trend in MA, CT, NY and other hockey dominant communities. Montgomery County is trying to stop the spread of COVID-19 quickly and they feel this may be a way to stop the spread. We want to cooperate with them to ensure the safety of our skating family.

We are confident in our policies and protocols and feel they have helped stop isolated incidents from spreading throughout our facility. We believe our response to potential cases has been quick and thorough. Our protocols and responses to any incident have been formed by information given to us by the CDC, Montgomery County, AAHA District, and USA Hockey respectively.

Our goal is to keep everyone on the ice and enjoying their sport as safely as possible. Our team has been working tirelessly to keep the building clean, ensuring everyone is wearing a mask, following social distancing guidelines, and keeping communication open to all.

This is a very tough decision but we want to work with Montgomery County Department of Health.
